**Halloween Costume Contest and Rules**

- Wildcard Club members can enter at the Wildcard Club between 2pm and 8pm on Halloween Day. Halloween Costume Contest is open to adults 21 and over.
- Winner must have valid Photo I.D. and a Wildcard Club Card.
- Employees of The Point Casino and judges of contest are not eligible. Decision of the Judges are final.
- The use of pyrotechnics are not allowed including but not limited to: fire, flash powder, explosives, smoke bombs or fireworks are not allowed as part of the contest.
- Costumes with electronic power must be self-contained.
- No live animals other than service animals.
- Full head covers and face masks are not allowed in the Casino. However they can be worn when having photo taken at the Wildcard Club. Masks need to be removed when in the casino.
- No weapons real or fake are permitted.
- No nudity is permitted. Persons wearing costumes that are considered lewd, obscene or offensive will not be allowed to participate in the Halloween costume contest or appear on stage. Whether a costume is considered lewd, obscene or offensive shall be at the sole discretion of management.

**Registration and Check-In**

- Entrants can register anytime between 2pm and 8pm on Halloween Day. Entrants need not be present to win
- All entrants will sign a photo release as they may be photographed and used in future judging and advertising.
- Winners will be announced and notified by Monday, November 2. Winners have until November 8 to claim prize.

**Judging and Prizes**

- A prize of \$500.00 will be awarded for four categories for a total of \$2,000.00 awarded. Prize categories are: BEST MALE, BEST FEMALE, BEST COUPLE and BEST OVERALL.
- Entrants can only enter into one category, Best male, Best female and couples. Couples will not be allowed to enter separately into other categories. Best overall will be selected from the three categories. If no entrants enter a category, then the prize money will not be awarded.
- Judges will determine the winner based on category entered and criteria of each category based on a 1- 10 scale. 1 being the lowest and 10 being the highest.
- All winners will need to fill out a W-9 for tax purposes.
