How do you bet?

Sports betting, at its core, is putting money behind an outcome of your choice and getting paid if that outcome is achieved. If a bet is on the winner of a game, then that is called a moneyline bet. If you're betting that a team will win or lose by a certain amount of points, that is called a bet spread. If you combine multiple outcomes into one bet, that is called a parlay.

What are the most common types of betting?

 Spreads, Moneylines, Parlays and Props (Proposition betting)
Spreads - The most popular form of wagering on Football, Basketball, as well as other popular sports.

A sportsbook will give the perceived stronger team a handicap in order to even out the playing.

- Moneyline Taking either team to win the game straight up. If you bet on a favorite, you may have to bet more to win less, i.e. Patriots - 140 means since you are betting the favorite, you would need to bet \$140 to win \$100. If you bet the underdog, you get paid a premium. Bengals +150, you would get paid \$150 for a \$100 bet.
- Parlays Combining two or more different Total and/or Point Spread bets. All bets must win in order to cash. Seahawks and the Over would require that they cover the spread and the total points scored.
- Proposition Bets Props can include any wager from total passing yards by your teams quarterback to which player in a basketball game scores 10 points first.

Additional terminology:

- Futures Bet A long term wager that will usually be decided at the end of a leagues season. Example: Chiefs to win the Super Bowl +600.
- Hook A half point in the betting line. Eliminates the chance for a game to "Push".
- No Action A wager where nobody wins or loses. Most commonly occurs when a game is unable to finish. Example: Taking the Over in the Mets/Yankees game and the game is postponed due to rain.
- Push When a total or final game score falls directly on the spread number. You will be refunded your wager amount.
 Example: Betting on the Patriots -3 and they win by exactly 3.
- Vigorish A percentage of money charged to the bettor when placing a bet. Also known as "juice". Example: Patriots -2.5 (-110)
